Service Contracts

Fire Services Administrator (FSA) Francis provided the board an overview of each

fire services agreement that CFD1 currently has in place. (Overland Park, Olathe, Miami County Fire District No. 2, Miami County Fire District No. 1 NE, and Miami County Fire District No. 1 NW) Maps illustrating each service area agreement were presented to the board.

Fire Stations, Apparatus & Personnel

FSA Francis provided the board an overview of all fire district owned fire stations and their locations. An overview and detailed accounting of all fire district owned apparatus was also provided to the board, including the age of apparatus and a vehicle replacement schedule. A brief discussion was held regarding the replacement of three fire engines that are currently 10 years old. FSA Francis advised the board that staff is working on a financial plan to fund replacement fire apparatus and that he anticipated presenting to the board in May or June. FSA Francis also provided the board a detailed accounting of the number of personnel employed by the fire district and where they are assigned.

Territory & Statistics

FSA Francis provided the board statistical data on population estimates, square mileage, and assessed valuation of the fire district.
